

Outline related to activities and its Five years plan of Bangladesh Association for Social Advancement (BASA) in relevance with SDG and its Targets:



Following the creditable achievement in implementing MDGs by the Government of Bangladesh, Bangladesh Association for Social Advancement (BASA) realized the need as an integrated role of non government organizations (NGOs) in achieving the targets of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs, 2016-2030) and accordingly started work to make a suitable and achievable 5 years plan(2016-2020) with a consideration of vision 2021 declared by Bangladesh Govt. as well as 7th Five years National plans in order to contribute plan better in achieving the SDGs and actions are also directed towards this commitment.

As an initial implementation preparation to contribute of Govt. Plan as well as for SDGs, BASA's five year plan the starting period which are tried to match. The BASA has started to do Mapping of Targets in the implementation of activities, Gap Analysis. Monitoring and Evaluation Framework for BASAs work in target area of Bangladesh which is on the way to get finalized. It is obvious that challenges that concern NGOs countrywide irrespective of how developed they are, such as disaster risk reduction, climate-change and its adaptation, migration, Political conflicts, Economical Imbalance cannot only be dealt with isolated efforts by individuals. With regards to the above, a combined exercise is recommended so as to provide a well-defined work plan that highlights all the actions necessary contribution to attain significant progress in the SDGs in NGO sector of Bangladesh. Although needs assessment study will help BASA to identify the need of adjustment is required to achieve the targets set by the different sectors.

BASA intends to play a contributory role in implementing SDGs at the grass root levels by operating in the remote areas and helping people to struggle the adverse effects of Economical imbalance. In addition to micro-finance services, BASA wants to be largely concentrated in following sectors relating to human development: (1) Poverty eradication; (2) Education; (3) Health, Nutrition and Population (4)Water, Sanitation and Hygiene; (5) Skill Development;(6) Disaster, Environment and Climate Change; (7) Rural Development; (8) Urban Development; (9) Agriculture and Food Security; (10) Migration; (11) Gender, Justice and Women Empowerment; and

With the consideration of the global strategic directions of BASA i.e.

1. Creation of livelihood opportunities for the poor and the disadvantaged.
2. Access to basic social services such as health, education and nutrition.
3. Sustainable management of the environment from the impact of climate change and disaster
4. Promotion of human rights, social justice and legal rights of disadvantaged groups
5. Development of competent staff through skill development and capacity building.
